

In the beginning God created the Universe - this was a Big Bang




The **big bang** is how astronomers today explain the way the **universe** began.

It is the idea that the **universe** began 13.8 billion years ago as just a single point, then expanded and stretched to grow as large as it is right now (and it could still be stretching).

Science is discovering new things about the origin and growth of the Universe all the time!!

The authors of the book of Genesis wrote two stories – about 2500 years ago - describing how God created the

These stories are not intended to provide scientific or historical truths

Their purpose was to teach us truths about God


In the beginning, when God created the universe, the earth was formless and desolate......

The power of God was moving......

The First Story

God created the world in 7 Days

On the First Day



God created light

On the Second Day



God created the Sky and the Sea

On the Third Day



God created Land which produced plants with fruit

On the Sixth Day

God blessed the Seventh Day and made it Holy because

GOD RESTED





God created the Sun, Moon and Stars to give Night and Day

On the Fifth Day



God filled the waters with living things and the air with birds

God created Animals

Today, astronomers have discovered that the sequence of the days in this Creation Story do actually mirror the sequence of events in current scientific theory.

The first story creation of the world teaches us....

God made ABSOLUTELY EVERYTHING!!

He was "pleased with what we saw" **Everything** he made was **GOOD**!! Every person he made was GOOD!!

> When he had finished... He was "very pleased with what we saw" Gn ch1 v31




He also taught us: The importance of RESTING from Work




The Second Story

The Lord God took some soil from the ground and formed man out of it; he breathed life giving breath into his nostrils and the man began to live



God made Adam and Eve








God said:

"You may eat the fruit of any tree in the garden, except the tree that gives knowledge of what is good and what is bad. You must not eat the fruit of that tree; if you do, you will die the same day." Gn Ch2 v16

The Devil in the form of a serpent (snake) tempted Eve to eat the fruit that gave knowledge of good and evil



As soon as they ate it, they were given understanding and realised that they were naked



Adam and Eve committed the sins of:

- 1. Pride
- 2. Disobeying God

Adam and Eve hid from God



Because they had rebelled against God they could no longer stay in the garden which was a place of total unity with God.

They must now work to cultivate the land and experience death

But God had a plan for the reconciliation and redemption for them and the whole of humanity!

He prophesied that there would be a woman whose offspring would "crush the head" of the snake

The second story creation of the world teaches us....

- God breathed his life into us
- Evil comes into the world when we disobey God
- The worst sin of all is the sin of Pride
- When we sin, we turn away from God

This story also teaches us that we are all born into an imperfect human race with a inclination to sin.

This second story of Creation explains this as our inheritance of the first sin of Adam and Eve

This is known as ORIGINAL SIN




We have done many amazing things with our understanding of science,

How are we using too much oil?


When we burn too much oil we create too much CO2.

We have cut down the earth's natural forests








Why is it bad for the planet when we cut down too many trees?

We have taken more than our fair share from most people on the planet, as well as future generations.












Let us Pray!




The more we get to know Jesus, the more our lives reflect him like a Mirror

The more we get to know Jesus....

The more we will follow his commandment:

Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.

John Ch13 v34-35



AND.....

The more we love one another......

The more we will glorify him by our lives!



Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life."

Jesus told us how to "Love one another as I have loved you"....

Look at the parable Jesus told in Matthew Ch25 v35-40

At the end of time, the King will say to the good people:

I was hungry and you fed me, thirsty and you gave me a drink; I was a stranger and you received me in your homes,

I was naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you took care of me, in prison and you visited me.'

They will then answer him, "When, Lord, did we ever see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you a drink?

When did we ever see you a stranger and welcome you in our homes, or naked and clothe you? When did we ever see you sick or in prison, and visit you?'

The King will reply, "I tell you, whenever you did this for one of the least important of these followers of mine, you did it for me!'

But....How can I do these things?

I was hungry and you fed me

- · I was hungry for someone to notice my needs
- · I was hungry for you to forgive me

I was thirsty and you gave me a drink

- I was thirsty for someone to explain how to do something
- · I was thirsty for someone to answer my questions

When possible we can do these things literally

There maybe less obvious ways...

I was a stranger and you received me in your homes

- I was a new person at school and wanted someone to welcome me
- · I didn't know where I was supposed to go and needed someone to show me

I was naked and you clothed me

- · I was being laughed at and I needed someone to stick up for me
- · I had made a mistake and I needed someone to help me correct it

I was sick and you took care of me

- I was fed-up and you helped to cheer me up
- · I had too much to do and you helped to make my life easier

I was in prison and you visited me

- I was stuck in doors and you called me
- · I was being bullied on social media and you stuck up for me

Remember..... When we give help and make friends with the least attractive people we are doing it for Jesus


