

Jesus

For thousands of years, God prepared people for the coming of Jesus



Moses lived 1300 years before Jesus was born.
He was a great leader who was very close to God.

Simeon prophesies that Jesus will be a light to reveal you will to all nations


He also warned Mary that a "sword of sorrow shall pierce your heart"

Jesus, Mary and Joseph escaped from Herod into Egypt.




After King Herod dies. The Mary and Joseph return home to Nazareth with Jesus



He was tempted to throw himself off the top of the Temple and put God to the test




He was tempted to be a powerful ruler

As Jesus walked along the shore of Lake Galilee, he saw two fishermen, Simon and his brother Andrew, catching fish with a net.

Jesus said to them, "Come with me, and I will teach you to catch people." At once they left their nets and went with him. He went a little farther on and saw two other brothers, James and John, the sons of Zebedee. They were in their boat getting their nets ready. As soon as Jesus saw them, he called them; they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired men and went with Jesus.

Jesus then told the servant to fill six 100 litre stone jars with water and take them to the wedding host




Jesus taught us about God
